HEATHFIELD & WALDRON TWINNING ASSOCIATION

When Le Marché was first launched in 1997 Wealden District Council suggested that some stall holders from Forges-Les-Eaux be invited. Forges is in an area called Le Pays de Bray with which Wealden is linked. Following the success of that initial market both towns decided that they were interested in a more formal relationship and discussions took place which resulted in a twinning link being established at a signing ceremony in Forges in May 1998.

Now in its 27th year the relationship has settled into a well established pattern with group exchange visits between the two towns taking place each year. This September we look forward to welcoming a party from Forges when we will celebrate with a weekend of visits to local places of interest and enjoy some convivial meals together - without which no exchange visit would be complete!

An important feature of any twinning relationship is the exchange of cultural, educational and sporting links and in the past this has involved a wide range of such activities but for several reasons these have all now lapsed. However both associations are keen to see links between our two towns expanded beyond annual group exchanges and we are already working on establishing links between schools and youth groups. The involvement of sporting and cultural organisations would be particularly welcome




